

MONOCOAT FUMED

DESCRIPTION:

Rubio Monocoat Fumed has been developed to create a special effect on oak by making the wood turn gray. This product reacts in accordance to the amount of tannic acid that is present in the wood. The treatment allows you to create very unique effects since the shade of gray depends on the amount of tannin in the wood. **Monocoat Fumed** is user-friendly and does not release any toxic or irritating fumes or vapors. This product is designed to be post-treated with **Monocoat Oil Plus**.

Attention: Variations in the final result can be expected depending on the quality and origin of the wood used.

SPECIFIC CHARACTERISTICS:

- Provides a “graying” effect to oak.
- Can be post-treated with **Monocoat Oil Plus**.
- Environmentally friendly, releases no toxic fumes or vapors.

APPLICATION:

- * Sand the planks until the desired result has been obtained.
- * Remove all dust from the surface.
- * Apply **Monocoat Fumed** evenly with a paint roller, brush or spray gun.
If a more uniform effect is preferred, the surface should be fully saturated with the product.
- * Once the wood dries, wash off the surface with water. Damp mop or wash with clean dampened cloths.
- * Allow the wood to completely dry.
- * Remove the raised grain by polishing the surface with a buffer and red or beige pad.
- * Make sure the surface is made fully dust-free again.
- * Apply **Monocoat Oil Plus**.

CONSUMPTION:

Depending on the method of preparation and the type of wood: +/- 175 to 350 sq. ft./liter.

TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Physical resistance at 68°F: Liquid
Color: Brown.
Odor: Characteristic.
Solubility in water (% weight): Miscible.

STORAGE:

The product can be stored for up to 12 months in dry conditions in the original packaging. Do not allow freezing.

PACKAGE:

250 ml, 1 liter, 5 liter jugs.
